

Ministry of Corporate Affairs has asked Companies and LLPs to declare affirmation of readiness towards Corona Virus Pandemic by filing web form CAR.

With Prime Minister Narendra Modi addressing the nation on the coronavirus (Covid-19) outbreak, the ministry of corporate affairs too has rolled out an advisory for chairpersons, MD and CEOs of companies urging them to contribute to stopping the coronavirus pandemic from spreading any further among the community. To begin with filing the **Company Affirmation of Readiness (CAR) towards COVID-19** form with MCA.

The form CAR will be **available from Monday**, **March 23, 2020** and needs to be filled by the Authorised Signatory of the company.

The main purpose of the company affirmation of readiness form is to confirm that companies or limited liability partners (LLP) are ready to deal with the coronavirus pandemic. With this, the companies and LLP will have to report their compliance with all the guidelines issued by the public health authorities to minimize the exposure of their employees.

All companies/LLPs are expected and strongly advise to put in place an immediate plan to implement the **"Work From Home" policy as a temporary measure till 31st, March, 2020.**
